Description:

Hillman Automotive was established in 2000 on Robinson Road in the Town of Lockport. Through the years, the company has expanded from its original 3 employees to 10. In 2005, the company was awarded Preferred Service Provider status by AAA. Hillman also offers quick lube oil changes, New York State inspections, AAA towing and general auto repair.

In order to expand to incorporate the servicing of recreational vehicles and fleet vehicle maintenance, the company proposes to construct a 14,000 square foot facility on vacant land adjacent to their current shop. This is the site of the former Kitchen World warehouse, which burned to the ground several years ago. There are a limited number of RV service facilities in Western New York and none presently in Niagara County. In addition, there are no privately owned fleet maintenance garages in the eastern part of Niagara County. The company seeks to provide a competitive alternative to service providers currently available for these markets. Hillman will also fill another void that exists in Eastern Niagara County by becoming a wholesale tire distributor for tire dealers.
