The proposed project (the "Project") includes the build out of a full travel center on three vacant parcels of land located at 6000 Porter Rd. in the Town of Niagara. PEMM LLC will build a travel center to include food accommodations for travelers and a service area for trucks that will provide maintenance and repairs. There will also be a weight station for trucks, to assist in meeting interstate transfer requirements and amenities available for those industry employees who require additional accommodations. PEMM LLC will service the tourist busses and host tourism materials, promoting local attractions. There will be refueling canopies to serve both the traditional travel, as well as the diesel consumer.

The NCIDA has determined that based on year 2019 Census data, the poverty rate for the adjacent census tract was 25.70% and the unemployment rate was 1.41 times the state average, for the year to which the date related, with respect to the adjacent census tract in which the Project is located enabled the Agency to determine that the Project is located in a "highly distressed area".

The project application and project summary are posted on the Agency's website at niagaracountybusiness.com and I have copies with me today.

The proposed financial assistance contemplated by the Agency includes New York State and local sales and use tax exemption benefits and mortgage recording tax exemption benefits (in compliance with Agency's uniform tax exemption policy).
